The Board of Mayes County Commissioners met in a Special meeting with all members present: Alva Martin, Chairman, Darrell Yoder, Vice-Chairman, Melvin Pritchett, Jr., Member, and Rita Littlefield, County Clerk. The initial notice of the meeting was received in writing June 10, 2010, and the agenda for this meeting was posted on the lower floor of the Court House at 2:00 p.m., June 15, 2010. Commissioner Martin called the meeting to order in compliance with the Open Meeting Law and the following business was done.

The following officers met with the Commissioners and the Excise Board to discuss their Estimates of Needs for FY 2010-11: Frank Cantey and Clarene Crittenden, Sheriff's Office, presented a request for \$1,027,580.00 for the Sheriff's office and \$881,000.00 for the Jail; Lisa Melchior, Assessor, presented a request for \$194,522.00 for the Assessor, and \$240,743.50 for Visual Inspection; Lori Parsons, Court Clerk, presented a request of \$429,876.00 which included the addition of eight employees to the General Fund; Darrell Yoder, Commissioner, presented a request for \$31,052.00 on behalf of OSU Extension Office, a request of \$40,000.00 on behalf of the Emergency Management Director, a request for \$22,224.46 on behalf of the Fair Board, a request for \$610,000.00 on behalf of the Health Department, a request for \$235,376.00 for the Commissioners, and a request for \$300.00 for Charity; Jill McCullah, Election Board Secretary, presented a request for \$79,325.24; Demecia Franklin, Treasurer, presented a request for \$212,800.00; Rita Littlefield, County Clerk, presented the following requests: \$3,500.00 for Excise Board, \$25,961.16 for County Audit, \$12,000.00 for Photo & Recording, \$1,069,247.72 for County Highway, \$640,018.06 for General Fund, \$1,019,219.18 for Fixed Charges, \$35,288.00 for Purchasing, \$712,831.80 for MESTA, and \$235,600.00 for County Clerk. Some of the Officers' requests included a 5% raise for their employees.

Motion was made by Commissioner Pritchett, seconded by Commissioner Yoder, to adjourn. Martin, Yes; Yoder, Yes; Pritchett, Yes.
