## December 5, 2011

The Board of Mayes County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting with all members present: Darrell Yoder, Chairman, Alva Martin and Ryan Ball, Members, and Rita Littlefield, County Clerk. The initial notice of the meeting was received in writing December 15, 2010, and the agenda for this meeting was posted on the lower floor of the Court House at 4:30 p.m., December 1, 2011. Chairman Darrell Yoder called the meeting to order in compliance with the Open Meeting Law and the following business was done:

Motion made by Commissioner Yoder, seconded by Commissioner Ball, to approve the minutes of regular meeting of November 28, 2011. Yoder, Yes: Martin, Yes: Ball, Yes.

Motion made by Commissioner Yoder, seconded by Commissioner Martin, to approve two Resolutions to deposit to the General Fund. One Resolution was to deposit monies received from the Pryor Tag Agency as a refund for the purchase of a vehicle tag which will be deposited to General Fund Maintenance and Operation, 20-2, and the other was a reimbursement in the amount of \$1,447.39 from Sheriff's Deputy Derrial Brad Bump for wages he received from worker's comp while he was still receiving his regular pay which will be deposited to the Sheriff's Salary Account, 04-1A in the General Fund. Commissioner Martin advised he had contacted Guy with American Leak Detection regarding hiring them to come to Mayes County to assist us in the search for leaks in the well field. They will charge us \$395.00 to come on site, and an additional \$129.00 per hour to locate the leaks. Phil Schoen, CEO of Geo-Enterprises, has offered to make any necessary repairs if possible.
