The Board of Mayes County Commissioners met in a Special meeting with all members present: Ryan Ball, Chairman, Alva Martin and Darrell Yoder, Members, and Rita Littlefield, County Clerk. The initial notice of the meeting was received in writing June 13, 2012, and the agenda for this meeting was posted on the lower floor of the Court House at 4:30 p.m., June 15, 2012. Commissioner Ball called the meeting to order in compliance with the Open Meeting Law and the following business was done.

The following officers met with the Board to discuss their Estimates of Needs for FY 2012-13: Michael Rose, OSU Extension Director, presented a request for \$46,660.00; Clarene Crittenden and Albert McKee presented a request for \$1,020,472.00 for the Sheriff's office; Lori Parsons, Court Clerk, presented a request of \$207,851.00; Lisa Melchior, Assessor, presented a request for \$192,258.00 for the Assessor, and \$252,104.98 for Visual Inspection; Darrell Yoder, Commissioner, presented a request for \$258,376.00 for Commissioners and \$300.00 for Charity; Kelly Brown, Fair Board President, presented a request for \$71,863.03; Jill McCullah, Election Board Secretary, presented a request for \$91,988.34; Demecia Franklin, Treasurer, presented a request for \$141,688.00; Darla Thompson, Administrative Programming Officer for the Health Department, presented a request for \$809,000.00; Rita Littlefield, County Clerk, presented a request for \$227,840.00 for the County Clerk's Office, \$901,530.93 for General Government, \$1,105,909.87 for Fixed Charges, \$3,500.00 for Excise Board, \$35,288.00 for Purchasing, \$29,440.27 for Audit, \$12,000.00 for Photo & Recording, \$747,430.10 for MESTA, and \$1,121,145.18 for County Highway. Some of the Officers' requests included a 3% or 5% raise for their employees.
