Commissioner Martin advised they probably needed to get with each barn to schedule meetings and Chrissy Rumsey, Insurance Coordinator for the Courthouse meetings like they have done in the past.

Brad Scott, owner of Southern Oaks Resort in Langley was present to discuss the current State Bridge Project that is affecting County Road E390. Mr. Scott is concerned about the trucks bringing fill from the Hoppers to the bridge and how it will affect his business. He is also afraid this project will hurt his business because he sells massages and is worried people won't be able to relax if they are getting blasted by dirt. He asked if he could have the Bridge Project Number. Commissioner Ball said that since it's not their project they don't have that number but he could contact ODOT or stop at the job shack and talk to Rob Turner. Commissioner Yoder advised him they could get him a phone number to ODOT. Mr. Scott was also concerned about the trucks messing up the road and who would fix it. Commissioner Ball advised him that the County Road Agreement they have with JenTech states that JenTech would be responsible for the maintenance of the road and have to follow State of Oklahoma DOT size and weight guidelines for hauling. He also stated that if at any point he could not travel down the road to call him.
