The Board of Mayes County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting with all members present: Ryan Ball, Chairman, Kevin Whiteside and Meredith Frailey, Members, Brittany True-Howard, County Clerk. The initial notice of the meeting was received in writing December 15, 2017, and the agenda for this meeting was posted on the lower floor of the Court House at 4:30 p.m., November 29, 2018. Ryan Ball called the meeting to order in compliance with the Open Meeting Law and the following business was done:

Bill Guthrie, was present to discuss agenda item 6b. He has two cabins and they are kind of hard to get to right now. He knows the revenues are going up in Mayes County with Google. All of these new things are bringing new jobs and new residents. They will be looking at how they can get in and out of properties when they go to buy.
