POLLING PLACE CHANGE FOR February 10th ELECTION

The polling place for Precinct 24 has changed, the Secretary of the Mayes County Election Board announced today.

Voters in Precinct 24 formerly voted at Unity Freewill Baptist Church, 208 W. Broadway in Mazie.

Effective immediately, the new polling place will be Mazie First Baptist Church, 206 D Ave. in Mazie. The first election held at the new location will be the Board of Education Election scheduled for February 10.

The polling location was moved due to the church no longer holding services.
